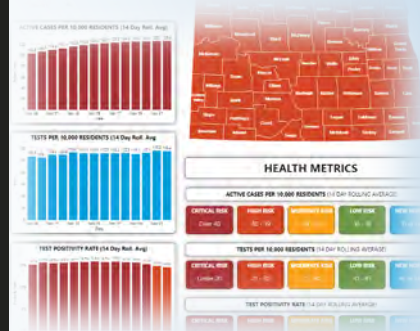


CASE STUDY

Local, county and state data reflect a rise in COVID-19 case rates and deaths in your county and its cities and towns. With community transmission rates near or over 10%, changes to COVID-19 testing protocols for staff and residents will be put into place.

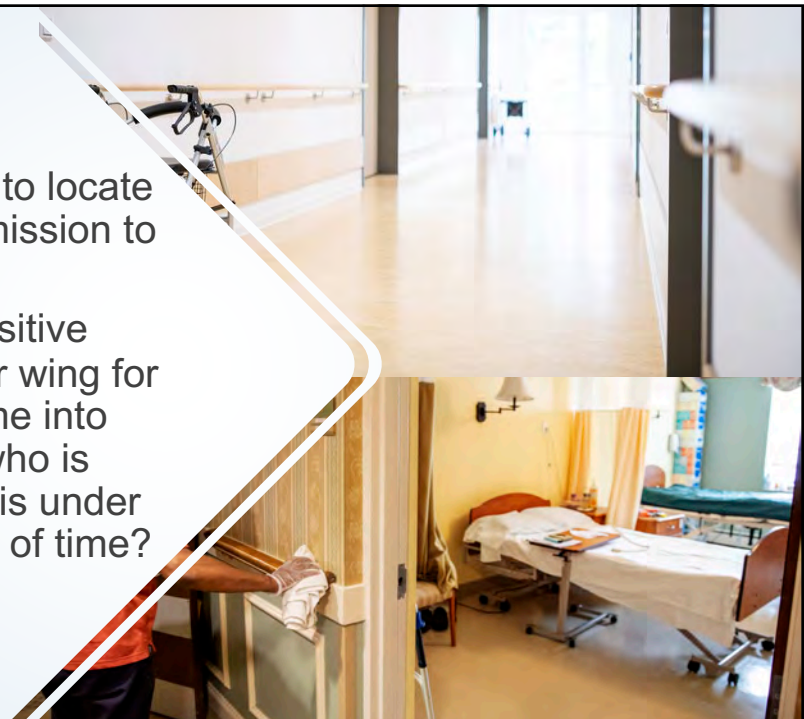
In addition, the administrator, DON and Medical Director have made the decision to:

- ▶ Limit visitation to outdoor visits only
- ▶ Contractors/vendors will be limited to essential workers/deliveries
- ▶ All new admissions will be quarantined in a specially designated area (unit) for 14 days, regardless of COVID-19 test status (positive or negative)
