



Exposure: 15 minutes within 6 foot radius

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### Staff return to work after symptomatic infection

- ▶ Use a checklist and keep a log
- ▶ Ask after 10 days of isolation:
  - ▶ 24 hours since last fever (and not using Tylenol or NSAIDS) ?
  - ► Are symptoms improved ?
- ▶ Return to work with mask
  - Surgical mask if still residual cough and other symptoms

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## Return to work after asymptomatic infection 10 days post COVID19 test

▶ Two negative respiratory tests x 24 hours apart



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#### Special cases of return to work

- ▶ If staff member on immunosuppressants, including more than 20 mg Prednisone daily, need 10 – 20 day isolation
- ► Consult physician for advise.



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#### Staff exposed to COVID19 at work

#### High risk COVID-19 exposures → quarantine

- ► Not wearing a surgical or N95 mask
- ► Not wearing an eye-shield when seeing maskless resident
- Conducting aerosolized procedure without full PPE

#### Low risk exposure → no quarantine but frequent test

- ▶ Continue work
- ▶ Daily symptom screen
- ► Screen more frequently

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#### Staff exposure to COVID19 at home

▶ 14 day quarantine



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# Adaptations Infected but asymptomatic staff can work on COVID unit Staff with low risk exposure may continue to work is symptom free
