Action	Primary Analysis Categorization
Stronger Actions	 Architectural/physical plant changes New devices with usability testing before purchasing Engineering control, interlock, forcing functions Simplification of processes and removal of unnecessary steps Standardization of equipment or process or care maps Tangible involvement and action by leadership in support of patient safety
Intermediate Actions	 Redundancy/back-up systems Increase in staffing/decrease in workload Software enhancements/modifications Elimination/reduction of distractions Checklists/cognitive aids Elimination of look- and sound-alikes Enhanced documentation/communication
Weaker Actions	 Double checks Warnings and labels New procedures/memorandums/policies Training Additional study/analysis

Sustainability = Data + Accountability _

Data

- Current
- Reliable
- · Related to resident care
- Useful for planning & evaluating care
- Accessible
- Provided in a useful form

Accountability

- Specificity at the unit, shift & department level
- Specificity to the daily or weekly level
- Objective outcome or process indicators
- Clear links between indicators & practice initiatives
- Clear designation of responsibilities
- Systematic data and evidence collection on a regular basis
